We are happy to announce a solution to petty cash payments. We have been granted the right by First National Bank to issue eWallet Pro Debit cards.

These cards can be used for petty cash purchases or to withdraw cash to fund minor purchases.

The advantage of the eWallet Pro Debit card is that this is safe and having to keep cash, and if the card is lost we can cancel it immediately.

In addition the funds are available immediately.

The card can be used for the following:-

- To withdraw cash from any Saswitch or FNB ATM.
- Can be used at a point of sale terminal
- Can be used as a point of sale cash back.

The costs involved are:

- Unlimited free swipes at any point of sale terminal.
- Issue fee of R50.00 once off.
- FNB ATM cash withdrawal fee
R500 = R6.00
R1000 = R12.00
R1000+ = R18.00
- Saswitch ATM cash withdrawal fee
R500 = R12.80
R1000 = R19.10
R1000+ = R25.40
- Point of Sale fee free
- FNB balance enquiry/mini statement free
- No monthly account fee.

In order for us to issue a card, we require:-

- A Trustees Resolution (attached)
- Copy of the ID of the person the card is issued to
- Their cell number.
- Proof of residence (if not resident at the complex)

Trustees can request the initial amount that is to be loaded on the card, and the card will only be replenished on receipt of the authorised vouchers.
